

You can be part of the solution!

Hope UK offers free training to Christians who want to enable children and young people in their community to make drug-free choices.

Training for Volunteers involves distance learning, and four practical training weekends. The course is accredited by the Open College Network. Once trained, each Volunteer is free to use the training in a range of different settings, with support from Hope UK staff and volunteers.

Volunteers must be willing to be drug-free (including alcohol and tobacco) for the duration of their time with Hope UK. A DBS check will also take place to ensure the safety of children. Once trained, Volunteers need to be able to commit to at least 2 hours a week for the work of Hope UK, but how the time is spent is flexible.
