

## Hope UK Prayer Diary January - March 2012



Attached, you will find some of the drug awareness sessions taking place from January to March. Please pray for the Drug Educators involved.

- Jan 1** At the start of a new year, please pray with us for God's guidance in all of our planning, decision-making, fundraising and drug awareness activities.
- Jan 8** Fundraising will continue to be challenging as the economic outlook becomes increasingly gloomy both here and abroad. Pray that God will supernaturally provide for Hope UK's needs.
- Jan 15** Pray for God's protection over our three trainers, Sarah Brighton, Lovisa Liyanage and Paul Coppeard. They have a busy year ahead of them with many new volunteers to train in different parts of the country.
- Jan 22** Clare Vincent, our Cornwall Project Worker, requests prayer for breakthrough in Cornwall. Seven of the ten people who had expressed an interest in the Drug Educator training have not followed through and she continues to recruit in the county.
- Jan 29** The Bexley team will have their last training weekend from the 3<sup>rd</sup> to the 5<sup>th</sup> of February. Pray that they will all quickly find opportunities to use their training in their community.
- Feb 5** There are a number of existing Drug Educators in the London borough of Lambeth. Pray for Paul Coppeard as he encourages them to start working as a team so that they can take advantage of opportunities to provide drug education
- Feb 12** Thank God for the hardworking Newham team of Drug Educators. Having completed their training in September, six of the nine volunteers have already taken their first assessed session.

- Feb 19** 'Catch-up' training will be held in the East End of London for volunteers from Watford, Newham and Bexley who missed out on one of the three compulsory training weekends. Pray that all are able to attend to complete their course.
- Feb 26** Nicola Molloy, our Northern Ireland Project Worker, still hopes to have a team of volunteers ready for training this year. Pray that those who have expressed an interest will follow through and send in their application forms. In the meantime, Nicola is keeping existing Educators busy!
- Mar 4** A new team of Drug Educators in Northamptonshire are due to start training this month. Pray that the volunteers will not be prevented by sickness or other circumstances from completing the course work and attending the first training weekend.
- Mar 11** Please pray for the planning of the training weekends in Scotland which are due to start this month; for venues, volunteer availability and for safe travelling. Also that more people will apply to be Educators in time to be included in that training.
- Mar 18** Ann Galbraith, our Project Worker for Southampton, Poole and Bournemouth has been busy raising Hope UK's profile in these three centres. A number of people have expressed an interest in the Voluntary Drug Educator Programme – pray that God will raise up enough volunteers in each town to form a team.
- Mar 25** The Annual Meeting and Educators' Conference will be held from the 30<sup>th</sup> March to the 1<sup>st</sup> of April. Pray for a good time of fellowship and learning and for safe travel to Ware in Hertfordshire where it will take place.
